



## Chisholm Creek Pet Resort's Pup Park Policies

1. Non-Member Dogs are NOT allowed – for the safety and well being of our members. If you have a friend or relative interested in becoming a member, please have them register as a client.
2. Dogs must meet all Chisholm Creek Pet Resort requirements – Dogs must be current on all vaccinations, current on flea, tick and preventative and shown no signs of aggression in group play.
3. Dogs must be on a leash until they are in the transition gated area of the park entrance.
4. You should keep your dog leash with you at all times.
5. No more than 2 dogs per person are allowed at one time in the park
6. Dogs must be under constant supervision by their owner and under voice control at all times
7. Please clean up after your dog and dispose of properly. Clean-up Stations are set up at the front of the park for your convenience
8. Humans are not allowed in any water feature
9. Children must be at least 4 feet tall to enter dog park and must be supervised by an adult at all times.
10. Non-alcoholic beverages are allowed in the dog park – but cannot be in glass containers. For safety reasons (risk of potential dog fights or food aggression) **food is not permitted in the park**
11. Females who are in heat are not allowed in the recreation area
12. The purpose of the park is for dogs and their owners to have a safe outlet for outdoor play. Hence, aggressive play and mounting is not permitted.
13. Any dog that consistently annoys other dogs by growling, mounting behavior or intimidation will be asked to leave the recreation area. Dogs that repeatedly display disruptive behavior will be banned from the recreation area.
14. Dog fights – the risk is always there that your dog may not get along with someone else's dog. For safety, we have provided air-horns in the park for you to carry with you. Should you encounter a scuffle between dogs, use the following techniques:
  - a. Make a huge alarming loud noise) with the air horn, your voice, clapping your hands)
  - b. Never grab a fighting dog by the collar or put yourself anywhere near a dog's mouth
  - c. Report the dog fight to CCPR staff

For Liability and safety reasons, we regret that the following breeds are **NOT ALLOWED** to become dog park members: **Pit bull Terriers, Pit bull Mixes, and Staffordshire Terriers.**
